- Q.** CMP's Real Estate Department manager, Ken Freye has stated that the gas pipeline we now know is located on our property in Eliot was negotiated for CMP by himself with the gas company, I believe in 1998. Please give the exact dates of the negotiations by CMP to use the Easement by the gas company, the copies of the contracts between CMP and the gas company or companies, the exact names of the gas companies and the exact nature of the land involved for easement use by the gas company or companies and location of that easement. In particular where is that easement as it relates to the CMP electric easement on our land? Please explain where the right of CMP exists within the Easement on our land to share the use with a gas company.
- A.** Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline, L.L.C., Portland Natural Gas Transmission System acquired certain easement rights or rights in easements from Central Maine Power Company (CMP) through a Judgment of Condemnation dated Sept. 30, 1998 (see attached) and recorded in the York County Registry of Deeds in Book 15384, Page 307. CMP spent several years negotiating the transaction and the exact dates of meetings are not now known. The natural gas pipeline easement is fifty feet in width and located along the southeasterly side of the Section 250 corridor in the area of the Fournier property. The rights acquired by the pipeline companies in areas where CMP has easement rights for its electric transmission corridor were limited to non-interference and consent by CMP; the pipeline companies needed to acquire additional rights from the underlying fee owner to perfect their natural gas pipeline easement.

**DESCRIPTION OF EASEMENT RIGHTS TAKEN  
BY PORTLAND NATURAL GAS TRANSMISSION SYSTEM AND  
MARITIMES & NORTHEAST PIPELINE, L.L.C. WITH RESPECT TO  
LANDS AND INTEREST IN LANDS  
HELD BY CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY**

**SECTION 1: NATURE OF RIGHTS TAKEN**

Pursuant to a Judgment of Condemnation rendered by the United States District Court for the District of Maine issued herewith pursuant to § 7(h) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717(h), Portland Natural Gas Transmission Company, a Maine general partnership, with an executive office at One Harbour Place, Portsmouth, New Hampshire, ("PNGTS"), and Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company with an executive office at 1284 Soldiers Field Road, Boston, Massachusetts ("M&N"), hereby take by exercise of the power of eminent domain and are hereby granted by Judgment of Condemnation of said Court, as tenants in common with undivided interests (each such interest being the respective ownership interests of PNGTS and M&N specified from time to time under an Ownership Agreement between PNGTS and M&N, their successors and assigns, dated October 8, 1997, as such may be amended from time to time), rights with respect to lands and interests in land held by Central Maine Power Company, a Maine Corporation with an executive office at 83 Edison Drive, Augusta, Maine ("CMP"), as hereinafter set forth. Hereinafter PNGTS and M&N are referred to collectively as the Grantees.

**1.1 Perpetual Easement.** Pursuant to said Judgment of Condemnation of said Court, Grantees hereby take and are granted, and CMP is permanently restrained from interfering with Grantees' exercise of, a perpetual easement ("Perpetual Easement") to prepare, lay, install, construct, maintain, operate, replace, repair, change the size of, alter, abandon, remove and conform to any applicable federal, state or local requirements a single natural gas transmission pipeline and all related equipment and appurtenances thereto (including but not limited to meters, fittings, tie-overs, valves, pipeline communications and data collection systems, regulators and pig launchers and receivers) (the "Pipeline"), and such additional rights as are incidental to the preparation, construction, repair, operation and maintenance of the pipeline as authorized by Grantees' certificates of public convenience and necessity or orders issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") or as required by the U.S. Department of Transportation regulations at 49 C.F.R. Part 192 ("Certificates"), under, over and across those portions of the CMP electric transmission line system corridors ("Corridors") to which both of the following conditions apply:

- (a) the lands currently owned by CMP in fee, including but not limited to the lands identified in Schedule I, which Schedule I is incorporated herein; and

- (b) the portion of the Pipeline Easement Right of Way that traverses the Corridors, as currently shown as the "Permanent Easement" on the alignment sheets ("Alignment Sheets") listed on Schedule 2, which Schedule 2 is incorporated herein. True and complete copies of the Alignment Sheets listed on Schedule 2 are filed in the respective executive offices of PNGTS, M&N and CMP first above identified, as those executive offices may respectively be changed from time to time by the respective management officials of PNGTS, M&N and CMP.

1.2 **Perpetual Restraint.** In perpetuity CMP shall not interfere with Grantees' preparing laying, installing, constructing, maintaining, operating, replacing, repairing, changing the size of, altering, improving, abandoning and removing the Pipeline under, over and across those portions of the Corridors as authorized by the Certificates ("Perpetual Restraint") to which both of the following conditions apply:

- (a) a leasehold, easement, license, permit or other lesser interest is currently held by CMP in the land affected by such Perpetual Restraint including but not limited to the lands identified on Schedule 3; and
- (b) the portion of the Pipeline Easement Right of Way that traverses said Corridors with respect to such lands as is shown as the "Permanent Easement" on said *Alignment Sheets*.

1.3 **Grant of Temporary Rights.** Pursuant to said Order and Judgment of Condemnation of said Court, Grantees hereby take and are also granted a temporary easement and CMP shall not interfere with, as the case may be, ("Temporary Rights") Grantees' preparation, construction and installation of the Pipeline, as authorized by the Certificates, using the areas encumbered by the Temporary Rights on the lands identified in Schedules 1 and 3 and shown on the Alignment Sheets, provided that structures may not be permanently installed in such areas. The areas in which the Temporary Rights of Grantees are applicable are identified on the Alignment Sheets as temporary work space and by any other equivalent appellation. To the extent CMP currently owns the land affected by Temporary Rights in fee, Grantees are hereby granted a temporary construction easement in such lands. To the extent CMP holds a leasehold, easement, license, permit or lesser interest in the land affected by Temporary Rights, CMP shall not interfere with Grantees' construction operations with respect to such lands. The Temporary Rights shall terminate, with respect to Pipeline Easement Right of Way, upon the earlier of completion of construction of the Pipeline and restoration of the Pipeline Easement Right of Way or July 31, 1999.

1.4 **The Pipeline Easement Right of Way Defined.** The Pipeline Easement, Perpetual Restraint and Temporary Rights are hereinafter sometimes collectively called the "Pipeline Rights." The areas of the lands described in Schedules 1 and 3 affected by Pipeline Rights as shown on the Alignment Sheets are referred to herein as the Pipeline Easement Right of Way.

**SECTION 2: DESCRIPTION OF PIPELINE EASEMENT RIGHT OF WAY**

**2.1 Location of Pipeline.** The location of the Pipeline and location and width of the Pipeline Easement Right of Way varies as is shown on the Alignment Sheets, provided however that the location of the Pipeline within the Pipeline Easement Right of Way is subject to ordinary field construction tolerances, and other changes approved by CMP which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. The alignment sheets identifying any changes shall be referenced in a notice filed in any appropriate Registry of Deeds.

**2.2 Limitation on Number and Diameter of Pipe.** Notwithstanding any provision herein, the Grantees may operate only one pipeline and the outside diameter of the pipeline pipe will not exceed 30 inches.

**SECTION 3: COLLATERAL NON-INCLUSIVE ENUMERATION OF GRANTEE'S RIGHTS**

**3.1 Collateral Rights.** Pursuant to the Judgment of Condemnation of said Court, Grantees take and are granted all privileges necessary and convenient for the full use of the Pipeline Rights together with ingress and egress by foot or vehicle along the Pipeline Easement Right of Way and any roads or public or private ways that now or hereafter traverse the Corridor, and CMP shall not interfere with such ingress or egress. CMP shall not interfere with Grantees' removal, cutting and clearing, as the case may be, of trees, brush, non-CMP owned structures, dwellings and obstructions that may injure, endanger or interfere with the Grantees' exercise of the Pipeline Rights. CMP shall make no excavation, change of grade or water impoundment, or place or erect any trees, brush, structures, dwellings or other obstructions on, under or across the Pipeline Easement Right of Way without the written consent of Grantees. The specific rights listed herein are set forth by way of example and not by way of limitation. Notwithstanding anything herein, the rights granted herein shall not exceed the rights authorized in the Certificates.

**3.2 Successors and Assigns.** This Description of Easement Rights inures to the benefit of and is binding upon the respective successors and assigns of PNGTS, M&N and CMP. Any assignment of this Description of Easement Rights is conditioned upon giving prior written notice of such assignment to CMP.
